

Hand Woven

Ten paper strips have come with this puzzle; each strip has five playing cards symbols on it. Your task is to weave the strips together (like pictured to the right) so that only half (twenty-five) of the card designations are then visible (the other half will be hidden by the weave).

Once woven, you can “score” your creation by evaluating all of the rows and columns. Each five-card row or column should be considered a Poker hand, and points are assigned based on how strong that hand is:

Straight Flush	65 Pts.
Four of a Kind	35
Full House	15
Flush	10
Straight	5
3-of-a-Kind	4
2 Pair	2
1 Pair	1

Your final score is the sum of those ten row/column scores. At 10:00 AM Sunday morning turn in your final configuration and score to Eric (you may want to tape the woven construction together for easy transport). All teams will have their formations graded at that time, and the highest scoring team will get first choice of the next prize envelopes. Second best score will earn second envelope choice, and so forth.
